Prof Margaret MacMillan:

There's a long silence until an aide speaks up

Aide:

Yes it is hard to decide.

Russian minutes:

His Majesty replied in a rough and displeased tone

Tsar Nicholas II:

I will decide.

Eventually the Tsar he gives way. It's said he's been warned that if Russia does not show that it's still a great power his dynasty may fall.
