Activity 2: Answer sheet

During a normal school week, pupils can spend up to 30 hours in lessons. However, according to a homework survey, only 75 per cent of pupils have a quiet space at home to read, write or study.

Schools have plenty of study space, for example libraries or assembly halls, so it would make sense for pupils to use these spaces to do their homework.

Therefore, children should have one hour a week when they can do their homework during lessons, since this will help them to do better in school.

Although this change would take up some lesson time, it could help 25 per cent of pupils to get their homework done.
