when evening changes into night.



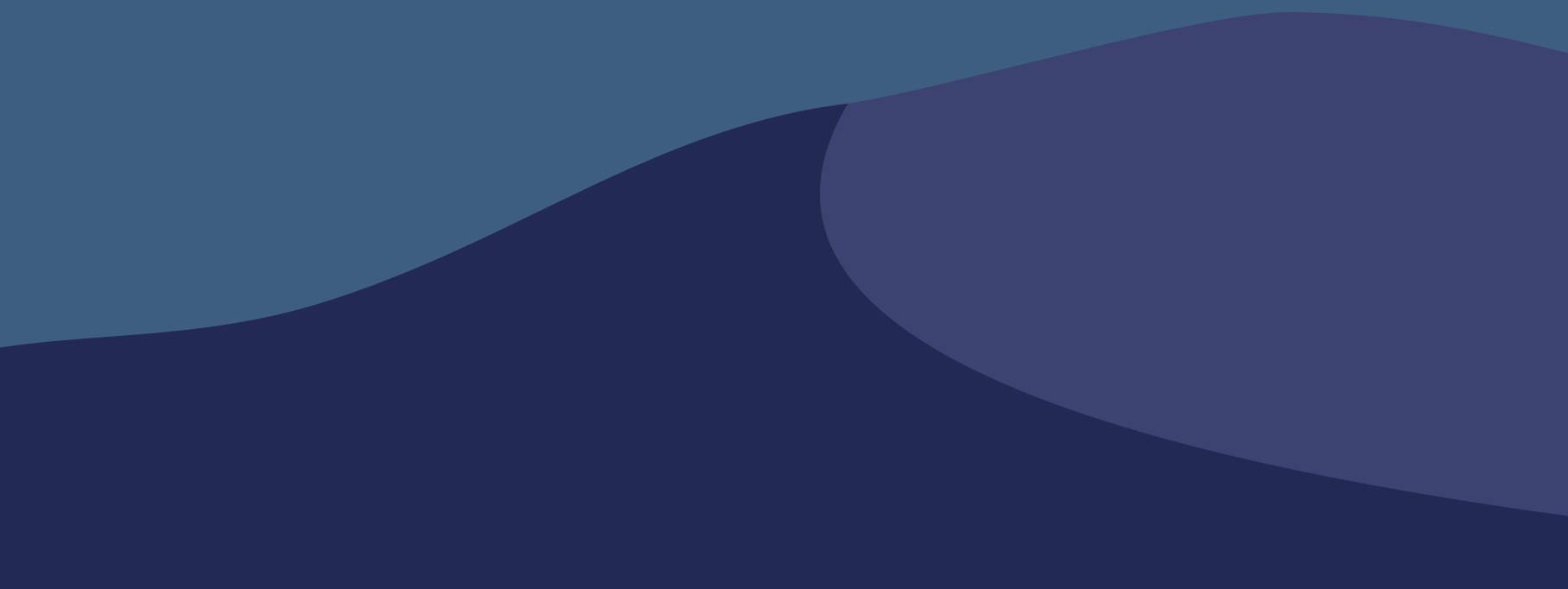
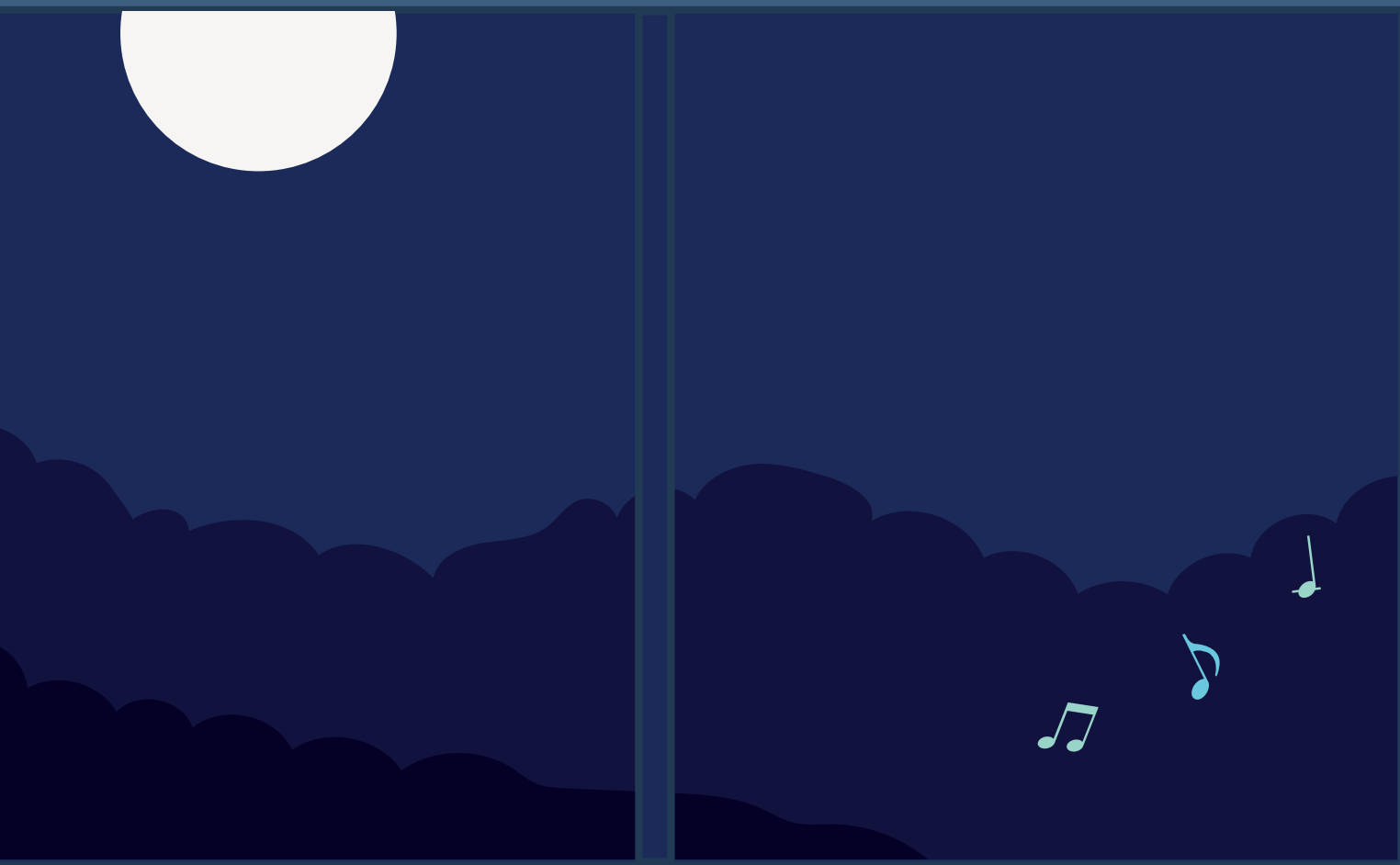
