




## Bar chart

Use this chart axis to visualise your data as a bar chart - each bar should go as high as the number of things found (frequency), eg squirrels.



## Pie chart

You can split this circle into a pie chart of your findings. Each number should be a fraction of 360, eg 4 squirrels would be  $360 \div 4 = 90$  degrees or one quarter of the circle. You can get an adult to help you with this.
