It was a success and the law was changed.</p>
<p>- In 1963 Martin Luther King made a very famous speech now known as the 'I have a dream' speech. He wished that all people would be treated equally.</p>	<p>- In the USA they have a special day so that people can remember Martin Luther King and celebrate his achievements.</p>	<p>- King worked hard at school and university and got a PhD. He became involved in the civil rights movement in 1955 because he wanted people to be treated equally.</p>	<p>- Martin Luther King was born in 1929 in Georgia, USA. His father was a church minister so he was brought up as a Christian.</p>
