

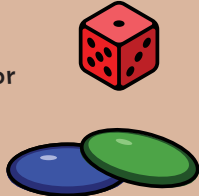


Around the world in 80 squares

YOU WILL NEED

- A die / dice
- One counter for each player



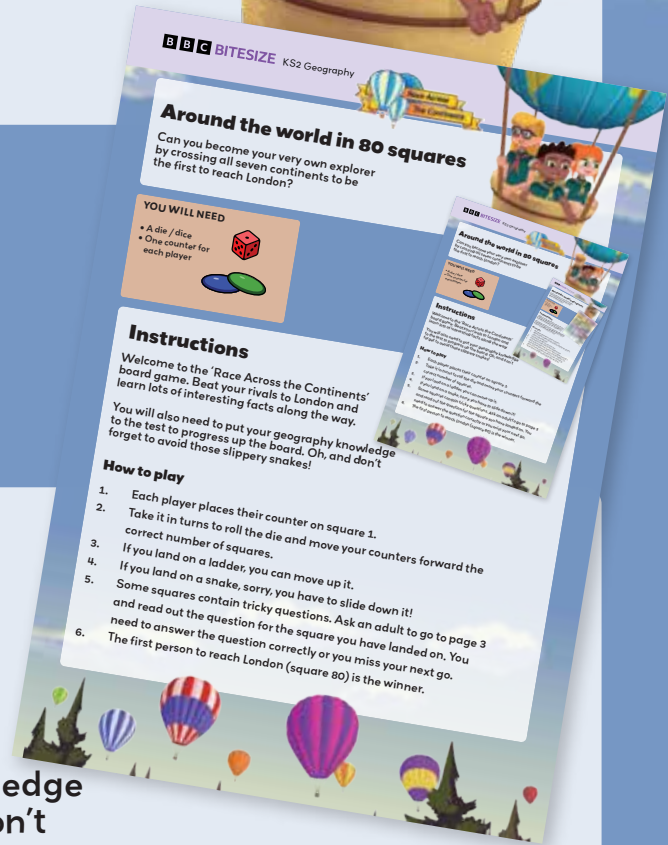
Instructions

Welcome to the 'Race Across the Continents' board game. Beat your rivals to London and learn lots of interesting facts along the way.

You will also need to put your geography knowledge to the test to progress up the board. Oh, and don't forget to avoid those slippery snakes!

How to play

1. Each player places their counter on square 1.
2. Take it in turns to roll the die and move your counters forward the correct number of squares.
3. If you land on a ladder, you can move up it.
4. If you land on a snake, sorry, you have to slide down it!
5. Some squares contain tricky questions. Ask an adult to go to page 3 and read out the question for the square you have landed on. You need to answer the question correctly or you miss your next go.
6. The first person to reach London (square 80) is the winner.
