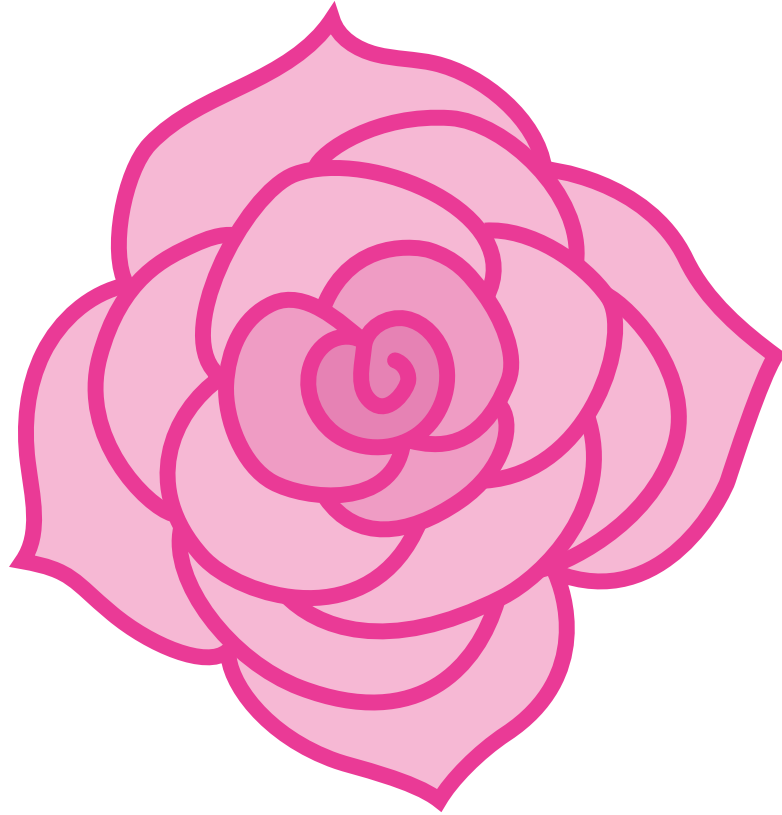

What is pink?



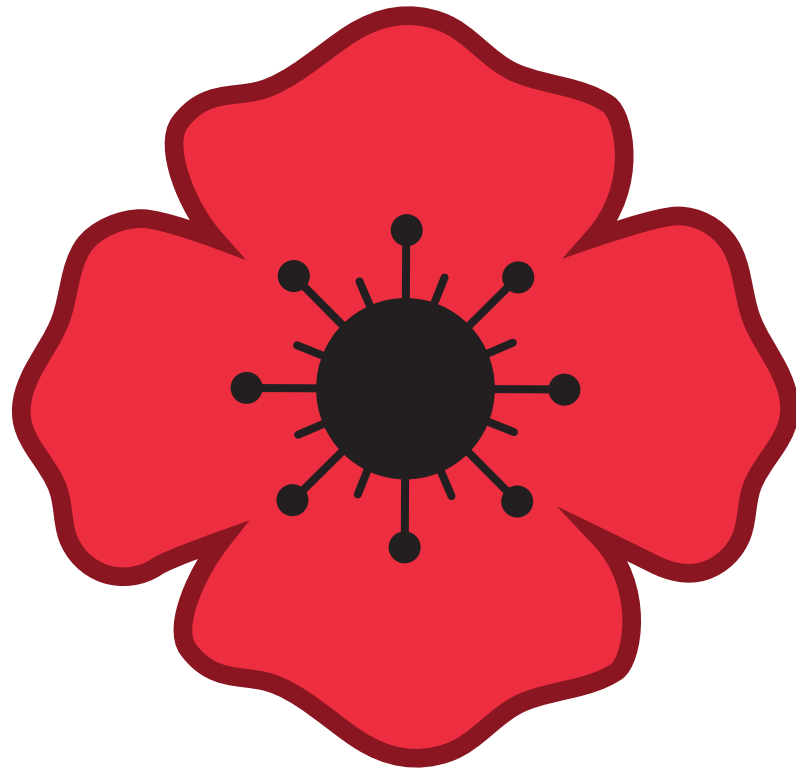
A rose is pink.



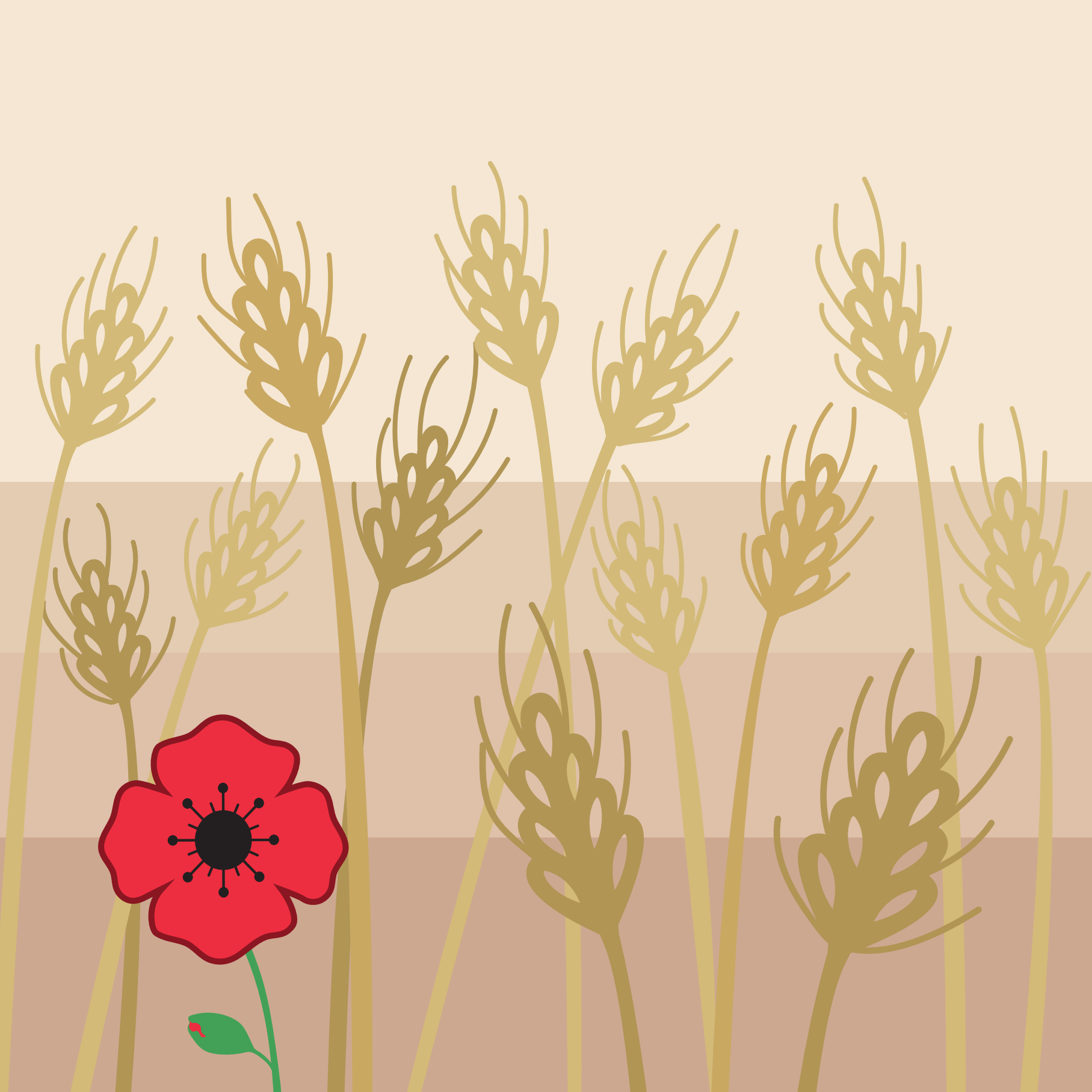
By a fountain's brink.



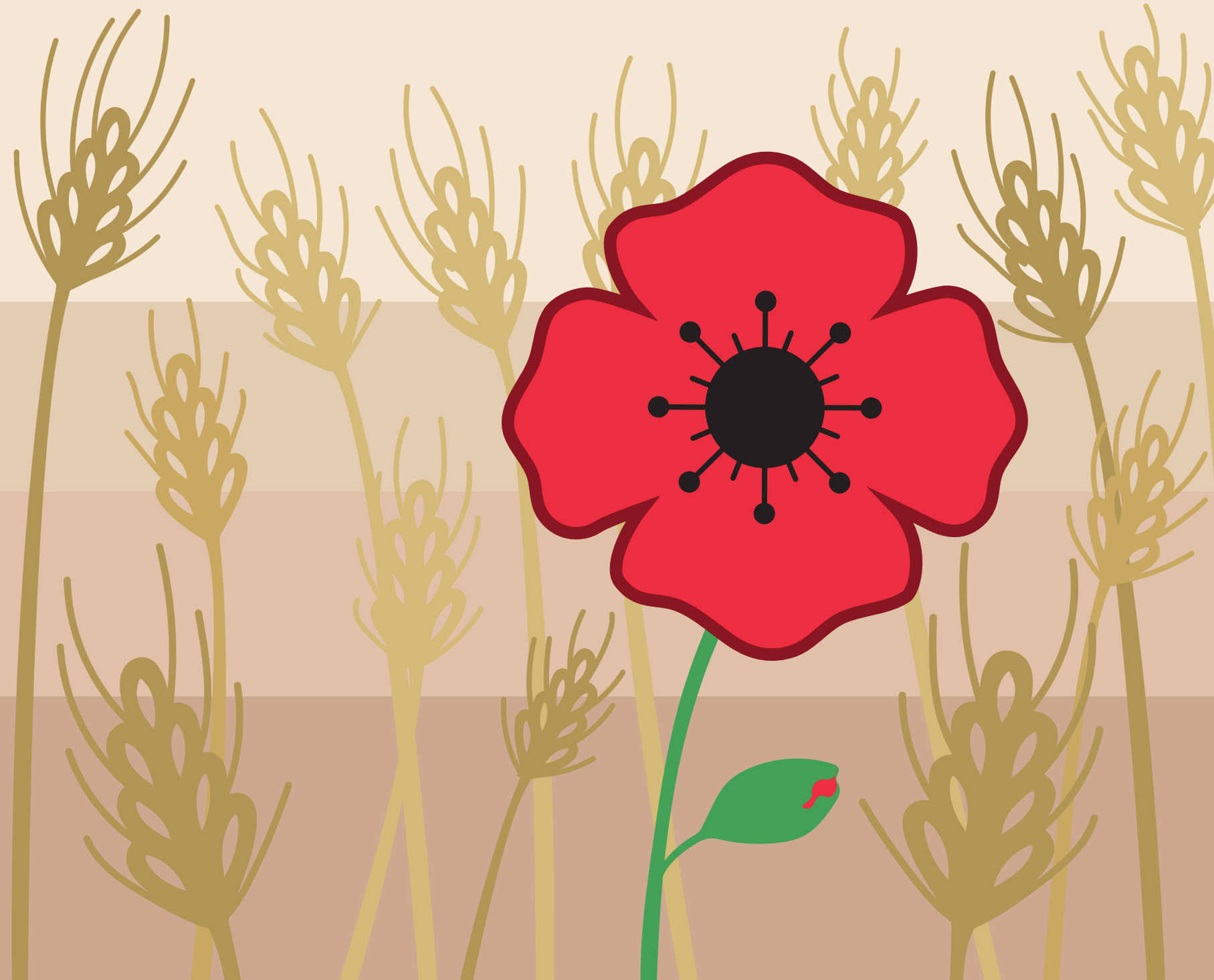
What is red?

Where the clouds float thro'



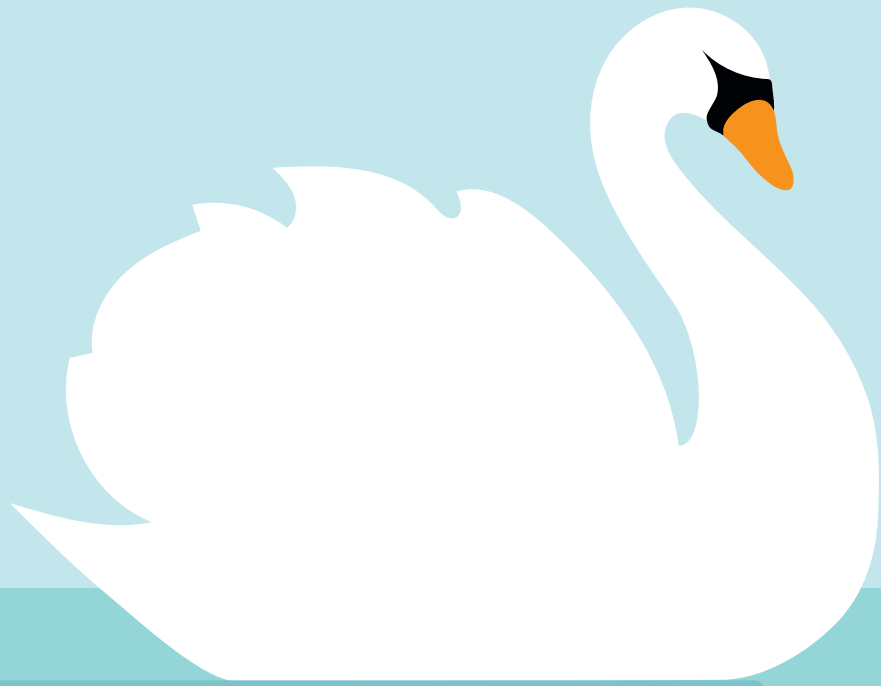
What is white?



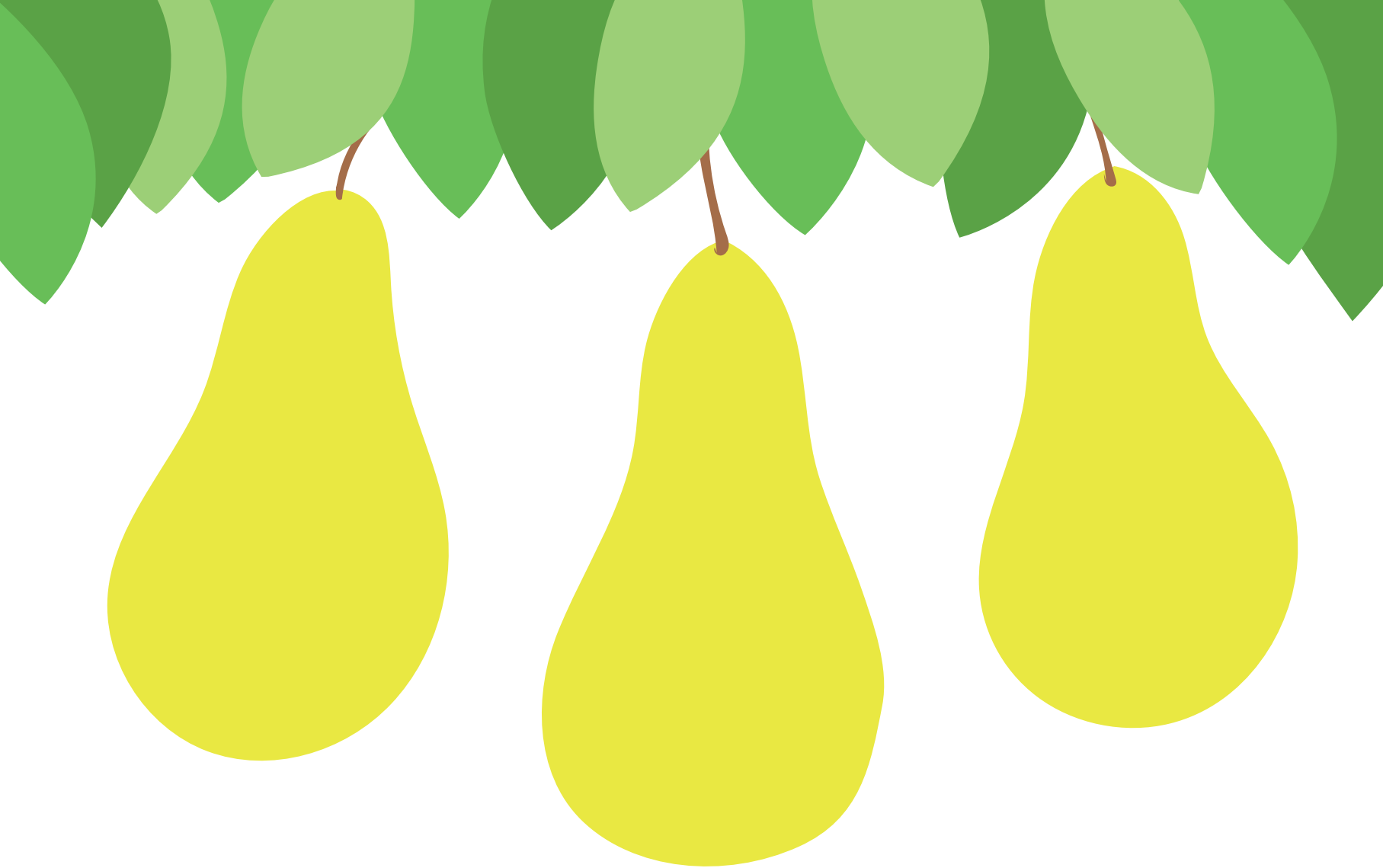
A swan is white.

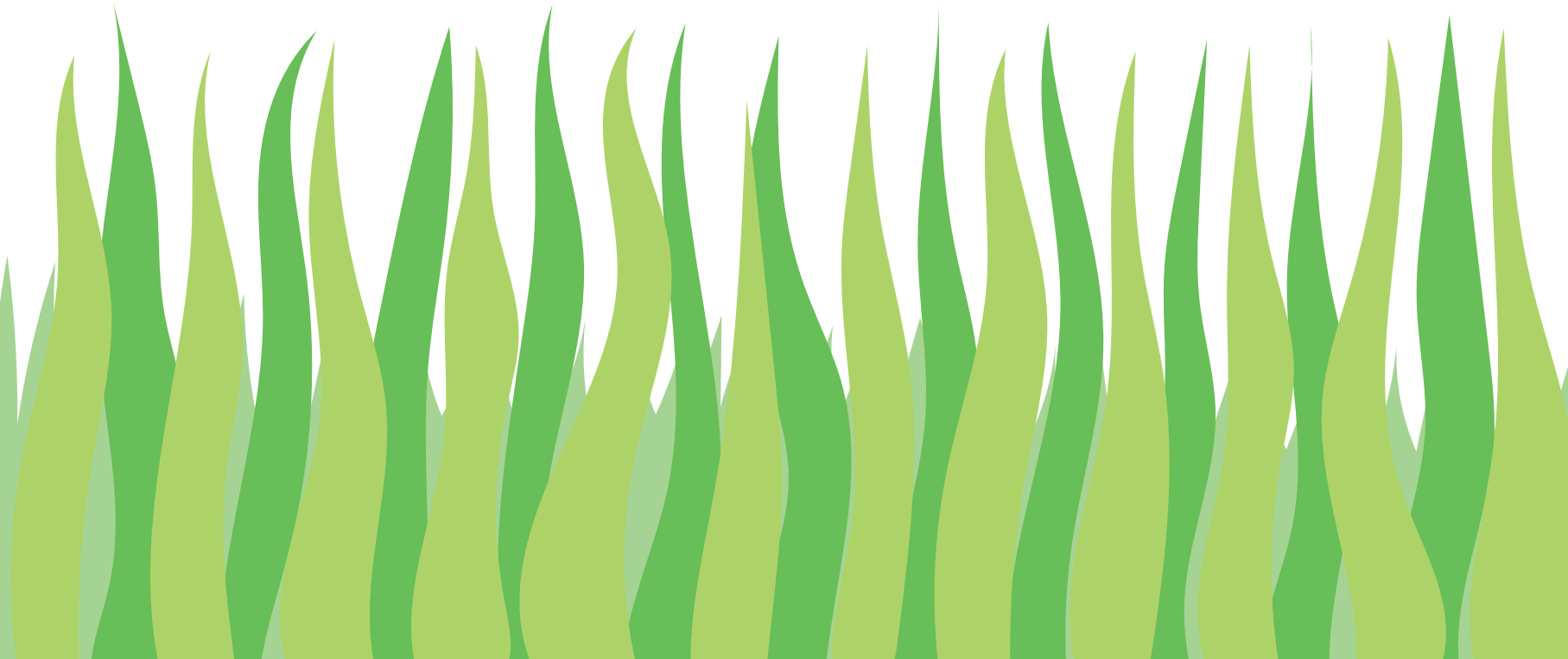

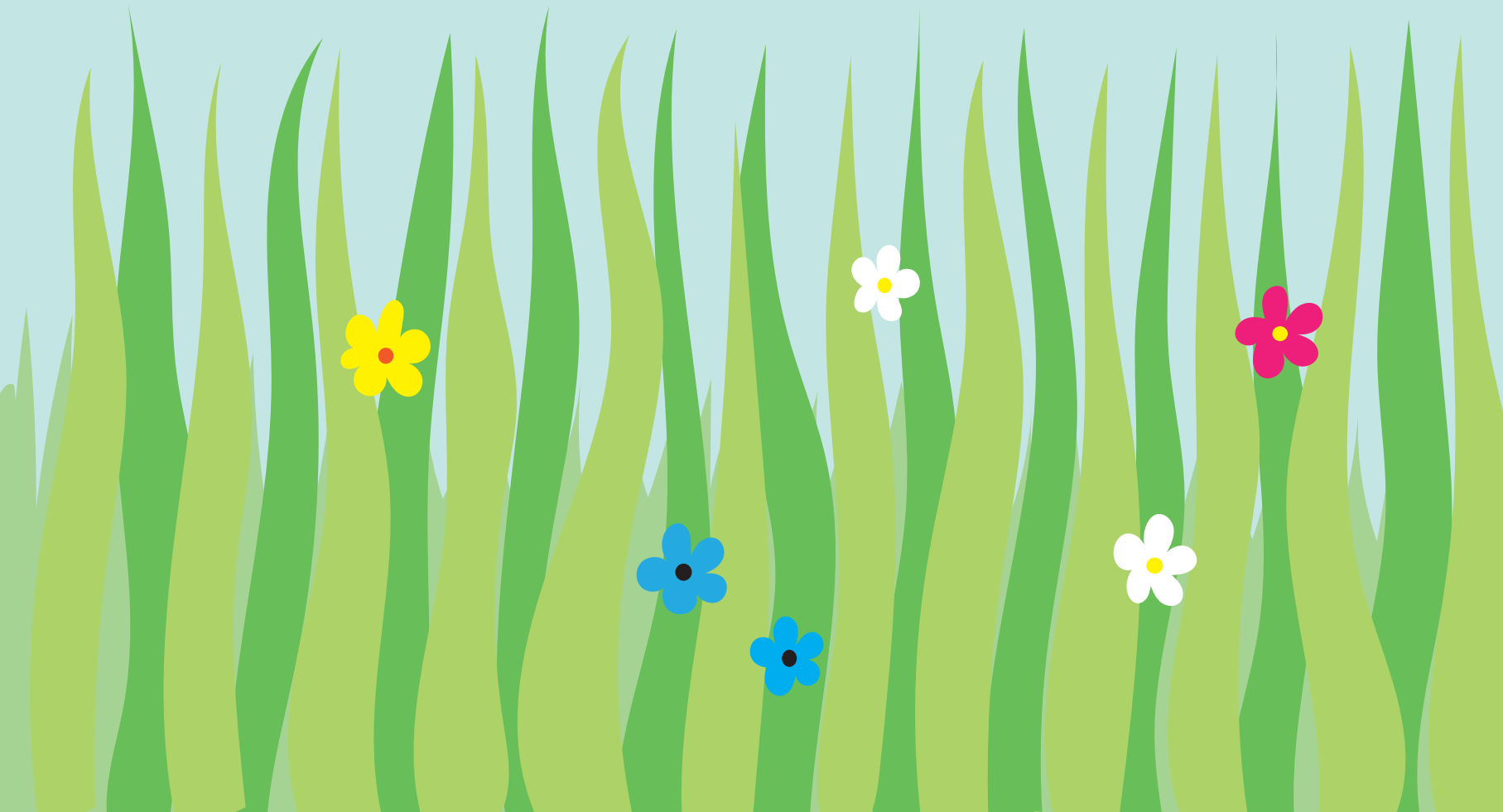
What is green?

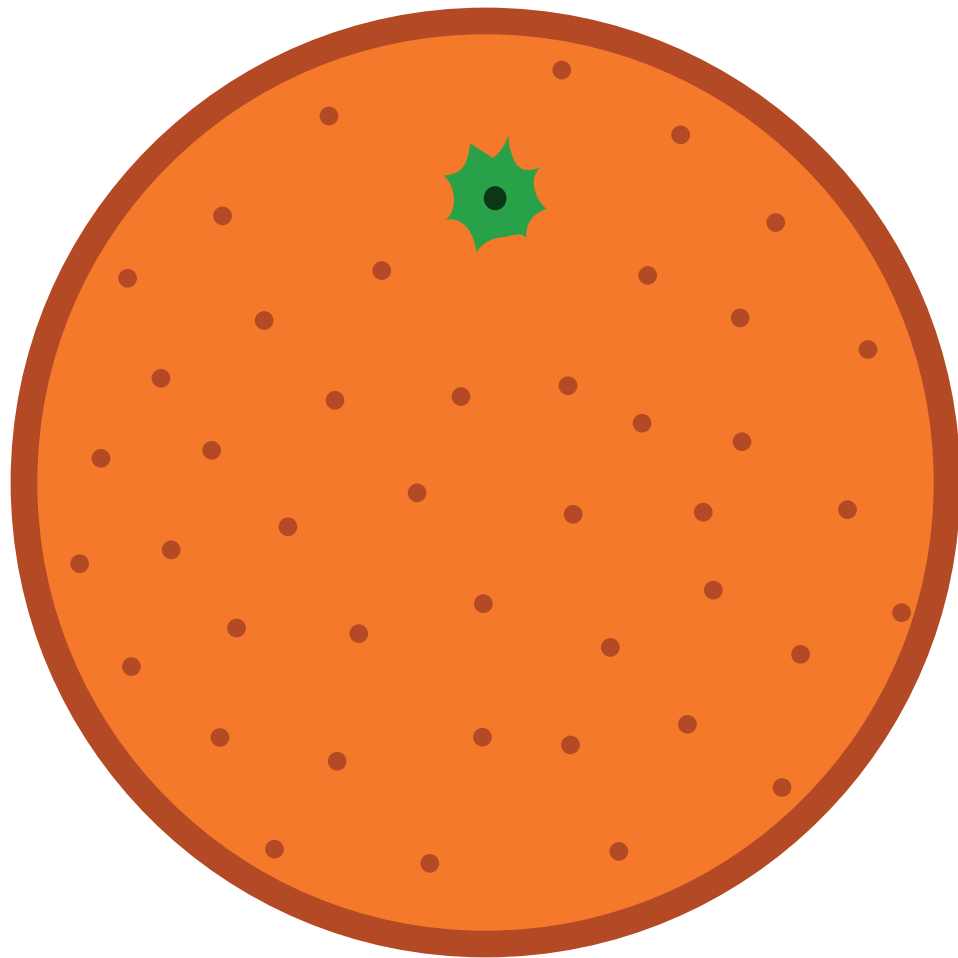
