


This poem could be used as part of a project on transport. Observe traffic moving along a nearby road and make a record of different types (digital photographs could be used). Each group of pupils could look at a different type of transport and make a display showing the adjectives they have chosen.

For example:





For example:







In the fruit bowl Five juicy strawberries Sweet and red Ready to eat
