French castle



What are French castles?

There is an area in France called the Loire valley, which is famous for its castles (**les châteaux**). They were built along the banks of the Loire river. Many have beautiful gardens. One of them, Ussé Castle (**le Château d'Ussé**), inspired the French writer, Charles Perrault, to write the story Sleeping Beauty (**La Belle au Bois Dormant**).



You will need :

- an A4 sheet of thin card (**la carte**)



- a pair of safety scissors (**des ciseaux**)

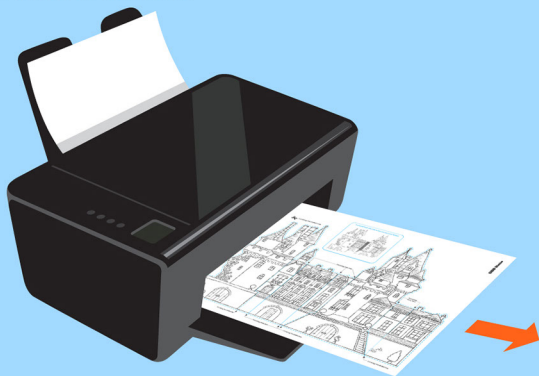


- coloured pens (**des feutres**)
or pencils (**des crayons de couleur**)

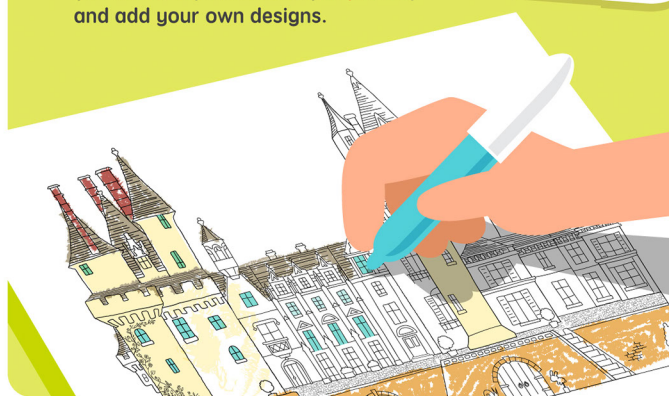


Method :

- 1 Print out (**imprime**) the template (**le modèle**) onto an A4 sheet of thin card.



- 2 Colour in (**colorie**) the windows (**les fenêtres**) and doors (**les portes**) and add your own designs.



- 3 Carefully cut out (**découpe**) the shape of the castle.



- 4 Fold (**plie**) along the lines.



The finished castle (**château**) should stand like this.

 Cut along the dotted lines.
