Ways to persuade the reader	Examples
Personal tone	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Yes, you feel• you just kick
Emotive words	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• horrible• lonely• uplifted• The world lights up
Rhetorical questions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What is it like to feel left out?• How about when you're playing a game with your mates though?
Say it again	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• So, get into teamwork
Undermine	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Some people say they work better on their own
Anecdotes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• But imagine practising football, where you just kick a ball against a wall• when you're playing a game with your mates
Direct	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• you feel• you just kick• you're playing a game
Exaggeration	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• over and over and over• dull, dull, dull!• the world lights up• a million times better
