1. Cut along the solid black lines only (the dotted lines are to show you where to fold).

3. Fold back the flaps along the dotted line.

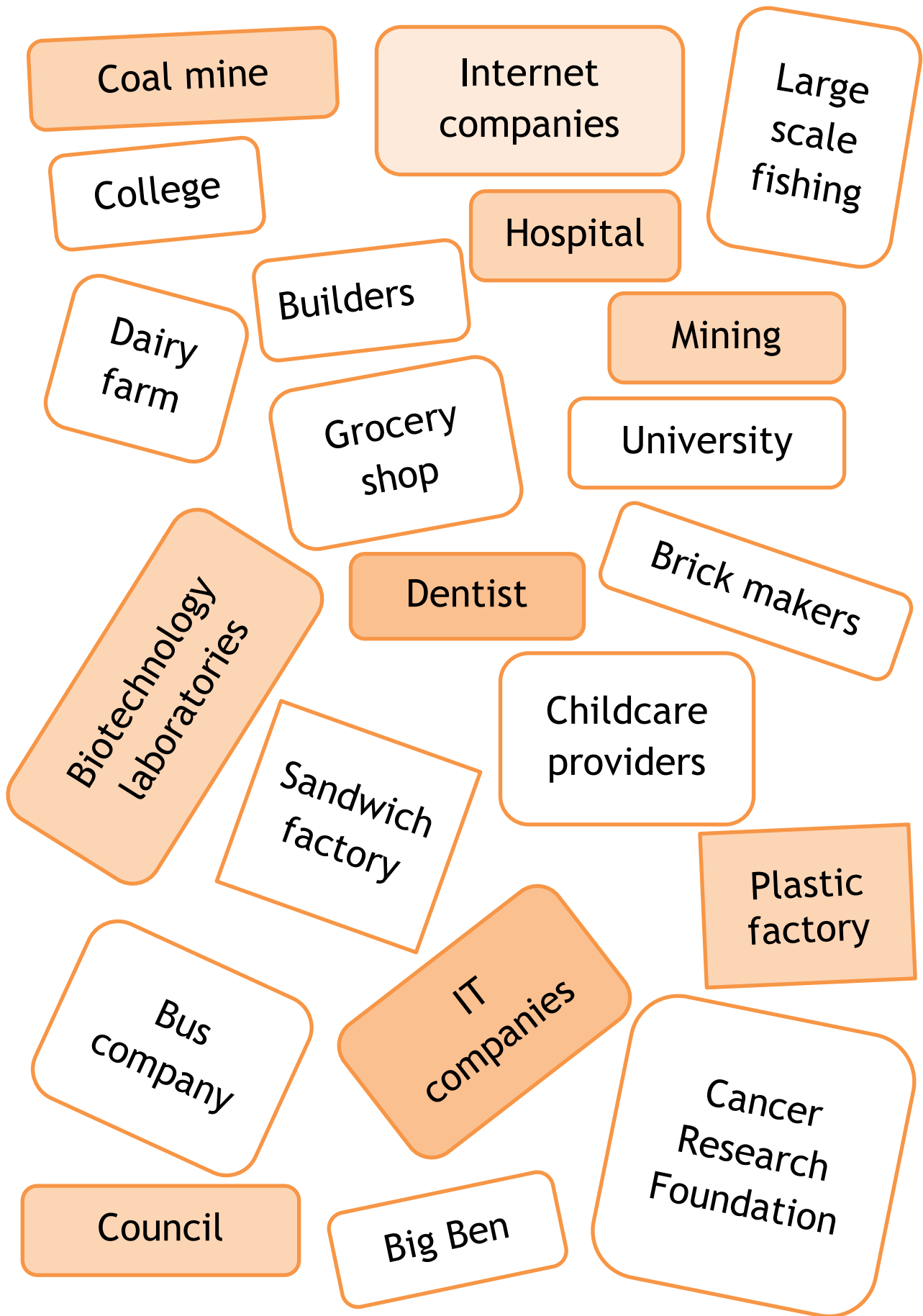

2. Sort the statements into the correct categories, so that you can write them under the correct flap for each category.

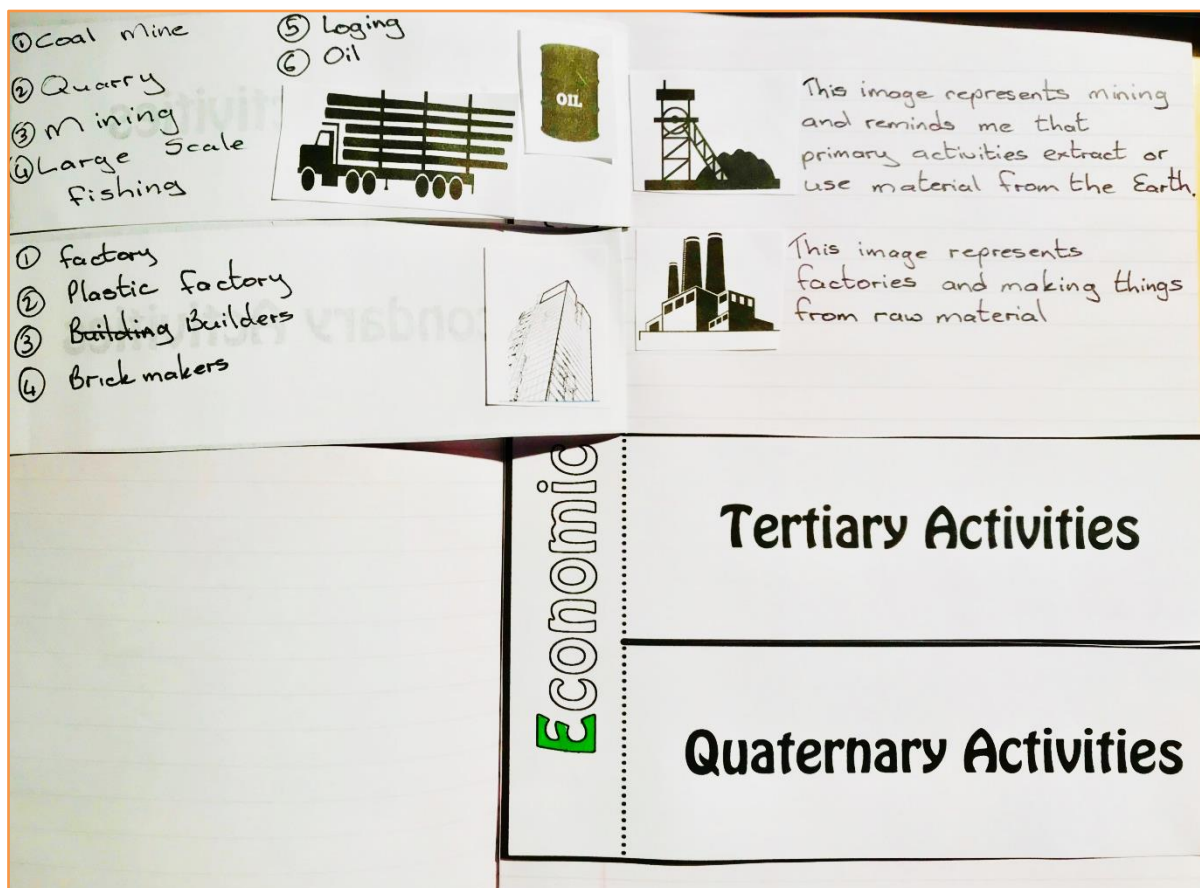




Student instructions:

This activity should take at approximately 30-40 minutes if all aspects are included.

1. Cut and paste your foldable from task 1 into your book, as the image shows:

4. One of the images needs a justification as to why you feel it best represents the category (this usually will have a reference to a definition - see the example below).
