



Stone Age Mammoth Paper Model

Here is how to make this lovely Stone Age Mammoth. It is important to understand what the different dotted lines mean when folding the mammoth.



Valley Fold (Fold up)




Hill Fold (Fold down)



Stone Age Mammoth Paper Model - Instructions

1. Cut around the solid black line for both shapes on page 1 and page 2
2. Taking the shape from page 1, carefully fold along all the lines. Taking care to notice that the folds are hill folds.
3. Begin to shape the mammoth body by gluing tabs 1 and tab 2 to the body to form the mammoth.
4. Taking the shape from page 2, carefully fold along all the lines. Taking care to notice that the folds are hill folds for all but lines on tabs 9 and 10.



5. Begin to shape the outer mammoth body by gluing tab 3 and tab 4 to create the rear of the mammoth.
6. Attach the outer layer of the mammoth to the body by gluing the two together with tab 5
7. Complete the attachment by gluing tab 6 to its corresponding side
8. Create the neck by gluing tab 7 and tab 8 to its corresponding sides.
9. To complete the head and the overall mammoth, glue tabs 9 and 10 to the head. Make sure you allow for the tusks on either side.
