



# Make a Ramadan Lantern

Ramadan is a very important holy month when Muslims pray and do good deeds.

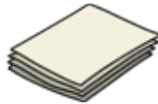
In some countries, people decorate their houses with colourful lanterns to represent light and hope.

## You will need:

- a printer



- an A4 piece of thin card



- a pair of safety scissors



- a glue stick



- some colouring pencils, felt tip pens or paint



## Method:

1

Ask an adult to print out the lantern template onto a thin sheet of A4 card.



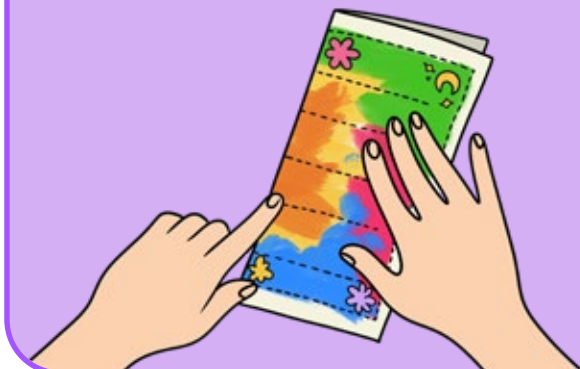

Colour in the lantern template and decorate it however you like. Colour some parts of it yellow or orange to show light.



## Method:

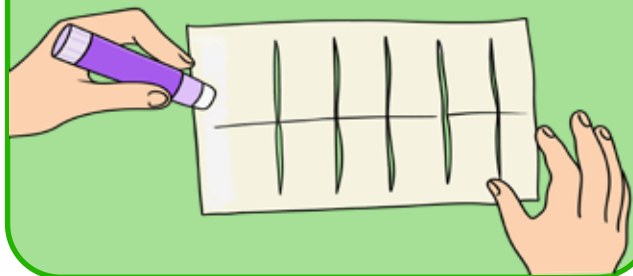
- 3 Fold the card in half lengthways.



- 4 Ask an adult to help you to cut carefully along the dotted lines. Make sure you don't cut all the way to the edge.



- 5 Unfold the piece of card. With the decoration face down, put glue along one of the shorter sides of the lantern.



- 6 Roll the paper into a cylinder shape and press the edges together.

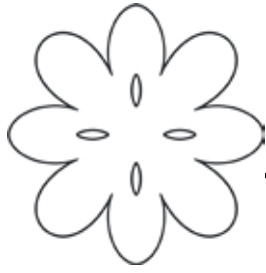


- 7 Take the small rectangle template and put glue at both ends.



- 8 Bend the rectangle and stick it to the top of the lantern to make a handle.

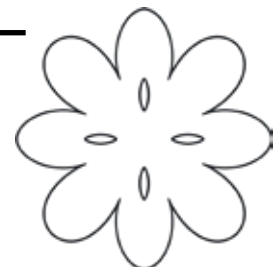
