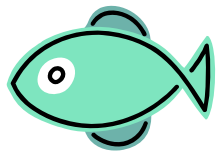


Making sense of sentences

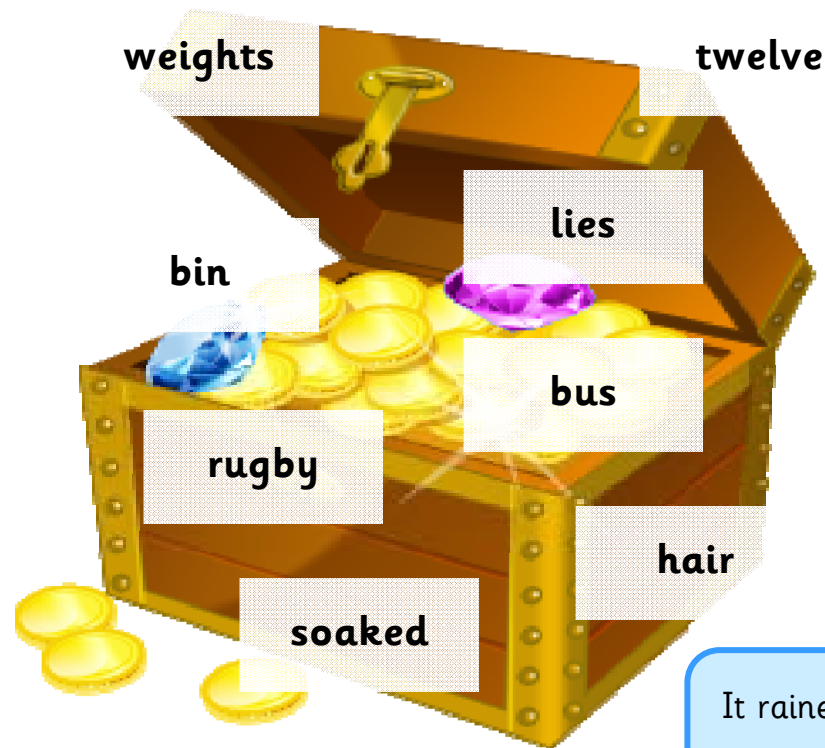
