Y gorffennol - The past

Now we're going to look at talking about or writing about things that happened in the past.

OK there are some irregular verbs or action words. All that means is that they don't behave in quite the same way as other action words.

These are the most important ones:

Es i – I went

Ces i – I had

Gwnes i – I did or I made

Des i – I came

With other verbs you need to change the endings of the verb to put them in the past.

Let's take **dawnsio** – **to dance** as an example.

Dawnsiais i – I danced.

So to help you remember. I did it in the **-ais** age! Get it, ice age. It ends with **ais**.

So all you have to do is use the ending which corresponds to the person you're talking about and you're away!

OK, so there we go. The past is history!
