



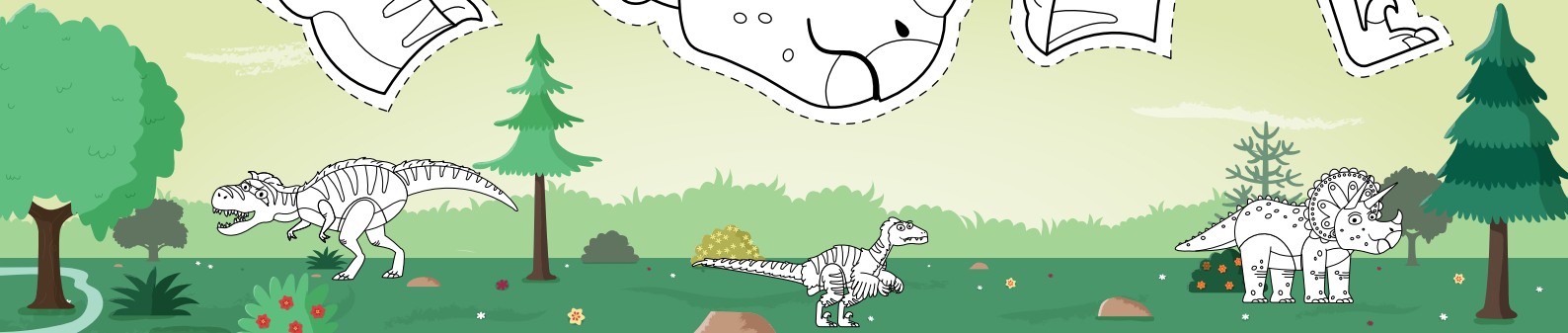
Dino detective

Dinosaurs came in many different shapes and sizes. Some dinosaurs, such as the huge Diplodocus, were **herbivores**, which means that they only ate plants.

Some of them, such as the T.rex and Velociraptors, were **carnivores**, which means that they only ate meat, including other dinosaurs! Dinosaurs, like the Oviraptor, ate both meat and plants. They were called **omnivores**.

The dinosaur parts are all mixed up! Can you cut them out and try to fit them together? There are three dinosaurs to sort and colour in.

When using scissors, make sure you have an adult to help you.



Dinosaur descriptions

Can you name your dinosaurs based on the descriptions below?

Velociraptor

This deadly dinosaur ran on two legs and used its large claws to catch its prey. A prey is an animal that is hunted and eaten by other animals.



Triceratops

This herbivore had a large frill and used its horns to protect itself.



T.rex

This large predator used its sharp teeth to tear at meat. Predators are animals that hunt and eat other animals.
