Te a choffi.

Coffi a the.

Secondly we use this mutation after ei meaning her.

If you're talking about **her nose** – ei thrwyn.

ei phen – her head.

Remember the word for **his** in Welsh is also **ei** but there is no **treiglad llaes** when you're talking about **his** something or other.

Lastly we use a treiglad llaes after the numbers tri a chwe.

For example.

Tri thŷ. Tri char. Chwe phensil.

And there you go, y treiglad llaes.
