## Various tenses Ateb le a Na - Answering Yes and No

So first of all let's look at how to say 'yes' and 'no' in the present tense.

The ones you'll probably use most are...

Ydw and Nac ydw.

So, any question directed at you starting with... Wyt ti?... will be answered Ydw or Nac ydw.

I'll give you some examples.

Wyt ti'n hapus?

Ydw.

Wyt ti'n mynd i'r parti?

Nac ydw.

OK ready for the next one?

Oes and Nac oes.

Anytime you hear Oes at the beginning of a question you will always know to use Oes or Nac oes as a response.

Oes 7 Iliw mewn enfys?

Oes.

Oes Ilun ar y wal?

Nac oes.

There are many more forms of yes and no yn y Gymraeg.

If in doubt, you can always just say wrth gwrs – of course or na.

Na covers every no answer so it's a very good cop out!
