Surprise someone special with a carrot gift cone

HANDY HINTS/TOP TIPS

- Scrap card can also be used as a paint palette
- Mix a little red paint with white to make pink
- Have some kitchen roll to hand when painting
- Whilst waiting for bits to dry, why not have a go at one of the other festive activities

When using scissors, make sure you have an adult to help you.

YOU WILL NEED

Materials:

- A4 paper (thicker paper or a few sheets rolled together will work)
- Cardboard / scrap card (for bunny gars, leaf tag and carrot tops)
- Decoration ribbon, buttons, glitter
- Pencil
- Craft glue
- Sticky tape
- Paint orange, green, white, red or pink


Equipment:

- Brushes & water pot
- Paint palette
- Scissors
 Stanlar
- Stapler

Take the paper and colour it with a wash of orange paint. Make your cone more sustainable, and interesting, by using old newspaper, sheet music or maps. Once dry, roll in to a cone and tape to secure the shape with tape. You may need to trim the top - ask an adult to help with this.



Lightly draw the shape of your carrot tops and bunny ears on scrap cardboard and cut them out. Use the templates on the next page if this helps. Check the size of them next to your cone.

3 Stick the two layers of the bunny ears together and paint them white with pink inners.



Take the carrot top cardboard pieces and peel in random places - once painted and scrunched a little this will help make them look more realistic. Paint the pieces green and leave to dry.



5 Stick or staple the carrot top pieces and bunny ears to the inside of the cone.

6 Now it's time to attach the ribbon handle. Staple the ribbon to the inside of the cone.

You could decorate your cone further using ribbon, old buttons or any other Easter bits you have.



Fill the cone with easter treats and go surprise that special someone.








Try mixing primary colours to create secondary colours:
